

**CONFERRAL CEREMONY OF THE HONORARY TITLE  
OF DOCTOR HONORIS CAUSA  
TO PHD PROFESSOR MARCEL AUSLOOS**

The valuable array of national and international professional and scientific personalities that have received the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies adds yet another prestigious member of the international scientific environment - PhD Prof. Marcel Ausloos, from the University of Leicester, Great Britain.

The proposal of the Board of the Faculty of Economic Cybernetics, Statistics and Informatics, approved by ASE's Board of Trustees and the University's Senate, was based on arguments such as the nominee's outstanding contributions to the field of statistical mechanics through the study of various chaotic systems that can be described using fractal and multifractal ideas; his widely appreciated achievements in the field of nonlinear systems and phenomena in a state of disequilibrium with the help of mathematical formalization and modelling of so-called 'exotic' physics phenomena; his innovative research in the field of econophysics and socio-physics; his valuable support and constant partnership with leading members of our academic community, resulting in joint authorship of scientific works published in internationally renowned journals, as well as the undertaking of two research projects with a consolidated budget of more than 2 million euros.
