The Bucharest University of Economic Studies climbes to the 201-300th position in Times Higher Education Impact Rankings 2025, released on June 18, 2025.

ASE is ranked 201–300th overall, as compared to 401-600th in the 2024 edition. The 2025 ranking includes 2318 universities from around the world. ASE has obtained a score of 80.1 points out of 100, and is ranked 2nd at national level, out of the 25 Romanian universities included in the classification.

The evaluation criteria for higher education institutions are based on the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) included in UN's 2030Agenda.

Regarding the objectives for which the reporting was carried out, ASE ranks as follows:

- ODD 1 *No poverty*: ranked 90th out of 1267 institutions;
- ODD 4 Quality education: ranked 301-400th out of 1975 institutions;
- ODD 5 Gender equality: ranked 31st out of 1559 institutions;
- ODD 8 Decent work and economic growth: ranked 101-200th out of 1350 institutions;
- ODD 9 *Industry*, *innovation and infrastructure*: ranked 301-400th out of 1156 institutions;
- ODD 10 Reduced inequalities: ranked 401-600th out of 1261 institutions;
- ODD 17 *Partnerships for the Goals*: ranked 101-200^h out of 2389 institutions.

The university's positioning among the global top 300 institutions reconfirms the commitment of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies to sustainability, equity and social impact and reflects its sustained reporting, partnership and institutional engagement efforts. The meritorious ranking on SDG 5 (31st place) and SDG 1 (90th place) underlines ASE's contribution to promoting equality and combating poverty.
