ASE is featured in the QS World University Rankings: Europe 2026, a leading international ranking recently released.

Compared to previous editions of the QS Europe rankings, ASE records a positive upward trend, strengthening its position among European universities and consistently remaining among Romania's top higher education institutions.

In the edition released on January 28, 2026, ASE ranks 442<sup>nd</sup> in Europe, 52<sup>nd</sup> in Eastern Europe, and 6<sup>th</sup> at national level.

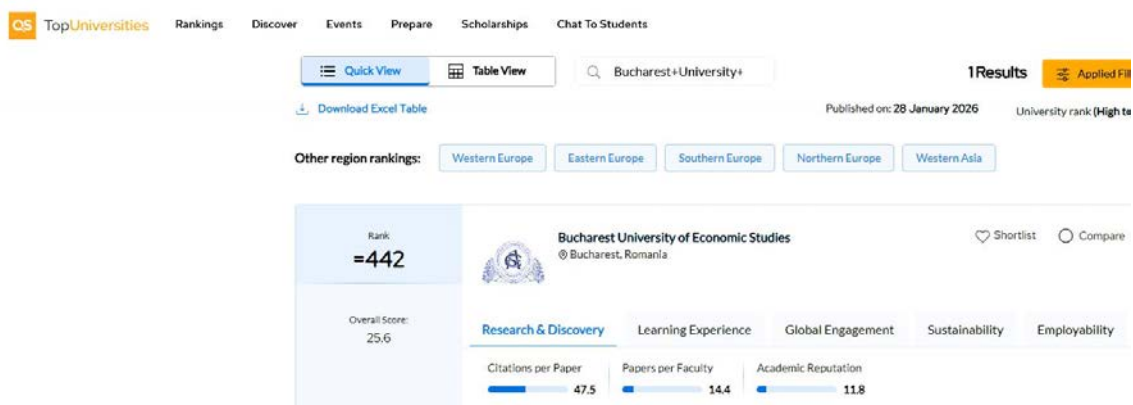
