

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
ASE's community mission

### 2023 - ASE's 110th Anniversary. Vivat Academia!

On April 6, 1913, the first Romanian economic higher education institution was established, under the name of the Academy of High Commercial and Industrial Studies (AISCI), as per a Law proposed by a committee led by Nicolae D. Xenopol, the then Minister of Industry and Commerce. The Law was elaborated by a group of leading Romanian economists, among whom we mention Virgil Madgearu, Victor Slavescu, Ion Angelescu. The Law was promulgated by King Carol I by means of Royal Decree No. 2978 signed on April 6, 1913.

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies is proud to have performed excellently for 110 years, being a leader of economic higher education in Romania and the region. In 2023, we also celebrate 55 years since the election of the current name of the institution - the Bucharest University of Economic Studies - ASE.





### ASE in international rankings

### ASE in the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2023

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies maintains its position in the field of Social Sciences & Management according to the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2023, published on Tuesday, March 14, 2023. ASE ranks 401-450<sup>th</sup> in the world in the field of Economics and Econometrics and remains 501-550<sup>th</sup> in the world in the field of Business and Management.

The QS World University Rankings is one of the leading international academic rankings by subjects. This year, the QS World University Rankings by Subject includes 1597 universities and a total of 54 disciplines, grouped into five major fields. The ranking evaluates and ranks higher education institutions based on a methodology that takes into account criteria related to academic reputation, employer reputation, the quality of research carried out (reflected by the research per paper and the Hirsch index).





### Launch of the 2023 Admission to ASE Campaign

At the beginning of January 2023, the University launched the 2023 Admission to ASE Campaign.

The institutional website has a dedicated Admission page for Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral programs both <u>in Romanian</u> and <u>in English</u>, with detailed information on Educational Offers, registration steps and procedures, enrolment numbers, as well as on student life and University Campus.

On Campus, **guided tours** are regularly organized during which groups of senior high school pupils accompanied by their teachers are welcomed by the representatives of ASE's Marketing and Communication Office, academic staff members and students, who provide informative materials and all necessary details on the educational offer, the steps of the July 2023 admission competition, as well as the facilities and professional opportunities offered by ASE to its students. Discussions are followed by visits to key sights of the University Campus.







Moreover, on February 27 - March 3, 2023, ASE organized the Open Days Week, dedicated to senior high school pupils interested in finding out details on Admission procedures and student opportunities. ASE received groups of pupils and accompanying teachers for information sessions and guided tours facilitated by representatives of ASE's Marketing and Communication Office, academics and students, who gladly answered any query regarding the Bachelor's Educational Offer and Admission 2023. for steps #BeAStudentAtASE!

Bucharest and throughout the representatives country, of ASE's Marketing and Communication Office and ASE's Students' Union continued 2023 Admission Educational Caravan started in November 2022. At the beginning of 2023, 37 colleges and high schools were visited, with pupils beina informed on the educational offer and the admission as having as well process, occasion to interact with academic staff members and current students.







# Launch of Postgraduate course entitled "Tourist Destination Manager"

In January 2023, ASE's Faculty of Business and Tourism of ASE launched the Postgraduate Course entitled "Tourist Destination Manager", organized with the support of important professional tourism associations: the Alliance for Tourism (APT), the Federation of Associations for the Promotion of Tourism in Romania (FAPT), the Federation of the Hotel Industry in Romania (FIHR) and the Federation of Romanian Tourism Employers (FPTR). The course is accredited by the National Qualifications Authority, and comprises 180 hours of tuition worth 23 ECTS credits.

### **Launch of Executive Certificate programs**

In January 2023, ASE's Bucharest Business School started the preenrolment period for the Executive Certificate programs "<u>Business</u> <u>Strategy and Digital Transformation - Executive Certificate</u>" and "<u>Business Development & Leadership in an International Context - Executive Certificate</u>", the latter organized by ASE, Bratislava University of Economics (EUBA) and Varna University of Economics (UEV).

Enrolments for the latter course began in March. Participants are to study how to develop a suitable business strategy in an increasingly interconnected and competitive global economy, how to adapt and develop marketing strategies and support brand development, how to build and lead teams and organizations and how to understand and exploit financial information in an intelligent business. The topics addressed in the 6 modules are: (1) Strategy and Business Agility; (2) Digital Marketing and Branding; (3) Talent Management and Team Development; (4) Financial Intelligence; (5) Leading People and Organizations; (6) Capstone Project – start-up Team Challenge.

### **Launch of Digital Skills Training Program**

On March 20, 2023, registrations began for the Digital Skills Training Program developed within the research project implemented by ASE – "Sustainable University through Digitization. Investments in Research and Education Infrastructure", financed under Component C15 – Education, as part of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan.

The project aims at:

- 1. Modernizing the education management information system and the e-learning platform;
- 2. Enhancing the equipment of the Data Center and improving the communication infrastructure of the Intranet-ASE;
- 3. The creation of specialized laboratories and the modernization of the equipment used in the educational spaces;
- 4. Creating advanced digital skills in the field of emerging technologies and improving educational and research activities.

The Digital Skills Training Program is correlated with the updating of the equipments used in the lecture and seminar rooms and laboratories, and with the new topics introduced in the curricula, and it consist of 4 modules: Module 1: Personal productivity in the digital environment (maximum 20 hours); Module 2: Artificial Intelligence (maximum 40 hours); Module 3: Communication, persuasive online skills based presentation offline on the use (12)hours); Module 4: Useful applications instruments collaboration in educational projects (8 hours).

The objective of the project is to train at least 350 teachers so as to develop advanced digital skills.

### **Modernization of ASE's campus**

Throughout January-March 2023, modernization and rehabilitation of key sights of the University Campus continued: the complete renovation and restauration of the "Nanu Muscel" House on 7 Piata Romana, the erection of the new building attached to it, and the refurbishing of the Aula Magna, the most beautiful and emblematic place of the Palace of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies (the seats were reupholstered, and the parquet was repaired, scraped and varnished). All these works are done in preparation of the celebratory events in April 2023, dedicated to the University's 110<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.








# Launch of the Erasmus+ project entitled "Digital Language and Communication Resources for EU Scientists" (DILAN)

On February 7, 2023, ASE hosted the launch of the Erasmus+ project entitled "Digital Language and Communication Resources for EU Scientists" (DILAN), aimed at the creation of digital resources and at the development of transversal competences so as to improve science communication. The project is co-funded by the European Union with the amount of 400,000 euros and is to be implemented between 2022-2025 by a consortium of five universities recognized for their expertise in specialized languages, communication and educational technologies: Université de Bordeaux and Université Clermont Auvergne (France), the Bucharest University of Economic Studies and the "Ovidius" University of Constanta (Romania), and the Oslo Metropolitan University - OsloMet (Norway), together with partners from the academic and private business environment. ASE's team is led by PhD Prof. Laura-Mihaela Mureşan.



### Launch of the Call for Papers for ASE's Annual Academic Conference – ICESS 2023

In February 2023, the Call for Papers was launched for the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of ASE's Annual Academic Conference – the International Conference on Economics and Social Sciences – ICESS 2023, on the topic of "Geopolitical perspectives and technological challenges for sustainable growth in the 21<sup>st</sup> century". The Conference is scheduled for June 15-16, 2023, and offers the following publication opportunities: Sciendo (DeGruyter) – Conference Proceedings, Springer – Conference Proceedings, Amfiteatru Economic, Economic Computation and Economic Cybernetics Studies and Research. # Information session on European Union funding opportunities in the field of Digital Health

On March 8, 2023, ASE hosted an Information session on European Union funding opportunities in the field of Digital Health, organized by the Ministry of Research, Innovation and Digitalization, and by the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA).

ASE was represented by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific research, development and innovation. HaDEA was represented by Marina Zanchi, Director, who launched the Call for applications, inviting Romanian universities, research institutes, local administrative departments, companies and NGOs to submit as many proposals as possible.

In the period 2021-2027, European funds amounting to 20 billion euros are available, with the following leading programs open for applications in the upcoming period: Horizon Europe, Digital, Industry and Space cluster (total budget 6.1 billion euros), Horizon Europe, Health cluster (HaDEA budget 5.4 billion euros), EU4Health (HaDEA budget 4.7 billion euros), Connecting Europe Facility (CEF – HaDEA budget 1.7 billion euros), Single Market Program – food safety (HaDEA budget 1.3 billion euros) and Digital Europe (HaDEA budget 0.8 billion euros).



### Workshop organized by ASE's Advanced Research Center

On March 10, 2023, ASE's Advanced Research Institute organized the workshop entitled "SMART objectives at the beginning of a research career", hosted by the "Virgil Madgearu" Room. Organizers from ASE were: PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, Rector, and PhD Prof. Margareta Florescu, Director of ASE's Institute for Economic Research. Guest speaker: Roxana Blagescu, entrepreneur, educator and neurolinguist. The mission of the event was to convey information on SMART goals at the beginning of a research career, to support those at this stage to clarify the "Why" of their scientific activity, to set goals and actions by developing a positive self-image, their qualities and competences. The event was dedicated to academic staff members, as well as Master's and Doctoral students from ASE, in order to stimulate interest in and, above all, to encourage participation in scientific research at the university.

The workshop was organized as part of the project entitled "Increasing institutional performance through the development of the infrastructure and the research ecosystem of transdisciplinary excellence in the socio-economic field" (PERFECTIS), financed by the Ministry of Research, Innovation and Digitalization.





### **International Conference entitled "Perspectives of European Business Law"**

On March 17, 2023, ASE's Faculty of Law and the Romanian Society of Business Law, in partnership with the National Trade Register Office, the Romanian National Association of Insolvency Practitioners the Competition Council, and the Romanian Chamber of Fiscal Consultants, organized the second edition of the International Conference "Perspectives of European Business Law". The event was held in a hybrid format, both online and in the "Virgil Madgearu" Room from the Ion N. Angelescu Building. The event opened by PhD Associate prof. Ioan Ovidiu Dumitru, Dean of ASE's Faculty of Law, benefited from the participation of guest speakers PhD Prof. Chantal Moll de Alba, Faculty of Law, University of Barcelona, Mr. Géraud Sajust de Bergues d'Escalup, Council of State, France, as well as of academic staff members, Doctoral students and practitioners from Romania and abroad, who discussed topical issues in the field of European business law.



### **Registrations for the Annual Students' Conference**

During March 6-20, 2023, registrations were open for Annual Students' Conference to be held on April 7, as part of the ASE 110<sup>th</sup> Anniversary events. 1193 students registered with 788 papers, out of which 949 Bachelor's students with 600 papers, and 244 Master's students with 188 papers. In total, 27 Bachelor's panels and 10 Master's panels are organized by all of ASE's Faculties.

#### International Conference on Business Excellence - ICBE 2023

On March 23-25, 2023, the 17<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Conference on Business Excellence- ICBE 2023, was organized by the Society for Business Excellence and ASE's Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages, in partnership with the Romanian Academy, the University of Bucharest and the Sapienza University of Rome, Italy. This year's topic was "Rethinking business: Sustainable leadership in a VUCA world". The event was opened by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific Research, Development and Innovation.



AMBA accreditation is awarded to universities and business schools for their portfolio of MBA and Executive MBA programs, following a complex accreditation process, being one of three prestigious international accreditations in the "Triple Crown". Worldwide, AMBA accreditation is granted to a maximum of 300 universities and business schools, being the way to enter an elite club. This initial step of joining the community is followed by the second major step, represented by the start of the accreditation process for the portfolio of MBA and Executive MBA programs organized by ASE's Bucharest

Business School.

### **Erasmus + Outgoing mobilities**

#### **Erasmus Caravan**

On January 12-20, 2-23, ASE's International Relations Division organized the Erasmus Caravan, in a hybrid format, including a mobile stand in ASE's buildings, where students received detailed information on internships abroad, financed by means of the Erasmus+ program.



### **Registrations for Erasmus+ mobilities**

On February 6 – 17, 2023, applications were received for Erasmus+ study mobilities for the 2023-2024 academic year. A total number of 472 applicants enlisted, and an Information session was organized online on February 14 by the Erasmus+ Bureau. Throughout the month of March several steps of the selection process took place: the language proficiency test, interviews with candidates, evaluation of applications, the announcement of admitted candidates – 347 out of 472 applicants. The remaining seats are to be open for a new selection in June 2023.

### Meeting with representatives of the Reform Alliance of European Universities




# Participation of CSU ASE chess players in the Kasparov Chess Foundation University Cup

In the Kasparov Chess Foundation University Cup organized on February 4-5, 2023, CSU ASE participated with two teams ranked as follows: one team was ranked 8<sup>th</sup> (after it defeated the team representing the University of Cambridge in the second round), while the other team was ranked 86<sup>th</sup> out of 116 participating teams. At individual level, David Gavrilescu ranked 7<sup>th</sup>, and David Cristian ranked 91<sup>st</sup> out of 548 de participating chess players.

KCF University Cup is a renowned international tournament organized by the foundation of the legendary world champion, Garry Kasparov, with the aim of making chess better known in the academic environment. This year, the tournament benefited from the participation of 116 teams from 4 continents.
