


ASE's Rector's presence at the Anniversary events of the "Lower Danube" University of Galați

ASE in the World's Universities with Real Impact (WURI) 2023

ASE is present in the World's Universities with Real Impact (WURI) 2023, ranked 25th for Innovation in Entrepreneurial Spirit and 101-200th for Innovation.

ASE is the only Romanian university present for three consecutive years in this prestigious ranking, designed to highlight and recognize universities' endeavors to form labor force aligned with the growing demands of contemporary society.

The WURI ranking evaluates universities based on new concepts such as degree of innovation, promotion of entrepreneurship, accountability and crisis management.



ASE in QS World University Rankings: Europe 2024

ASE is present in the first edition of QS World University Rankings: Europe 2024 released on September 20, 2023, which evaluates higher education institutions in member countries of the Council of Europe. This year's edition ranks 688 European universities, 17 universities from Romania, including member universities of the Universitaria Consortium.

The ranking highlights ASE's reputation among employers, as well as the number of articles jointly authored by academics and researchers from ASE with foreign academics and researchers.

The ranking is elaborated by London-based QS Quacquarelli Symonds, based on criteria such as: academic reputation, employer reputation and employment outcomes, quality of scientific research (citations per paper, papers per faculty, international research network), guality of teaching and learning activities (faculty student ratio), international exposure (international student diversity, international faculty ratio, inbound exchange student ratio. outbound exchange student ratio). and sustainability score.



ASE in international rankings

ASE in Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2024

For the fifth consecutive year, the Bucharest University of Economic Studies is ranked 1st in Romania and 801 – 1000th overall, according to the prestigious Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2024, published on September 27, 2023.

The 20th annual edition of THE World University Rankings includes nearly 2,000 universities from around the world, following the evaluation of 2,673 institutions from 127 countries, a record in recent years. The international ranking agency considers five main aspects to define the ranking methodology: the teaching and learning environment, the research environment, the quality and influence of research, the transfer of knowledge to industry and the international perspective of the university.

ASE in World Rankings for Best Universities for International Students 2023 – 2024

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies has been included, for the first time, in the "World Rankings for Best Universities for International Students" 2023-2024 conducted by Study Abroad Aide, South Korea. ASE ranks 538 out of 8052 universities in 72 countries.



2023 Admission to ASE's Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral study programs


In July and September 2023, ASE organized one of the most important activities for the University – the Admission contest for its Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral programs.

During the Admission period, volunteering students and members of the University's Marketing and Communication Office answered calls from interested Bachelor's candidates 8 hours a day, and more than 8000 calls, Facebook, Instagram and e-mail queries were answered. Phone and e-mail queries from Master's candidates were answered by representatives of ASE's Center for Career Counseling and Guidance and the Marketing and Communication Office.

ASE's Board of Trustees express their appreciation for the efforts undertaken by all those involved in the Admission process: members of the Admission Commissions, of the Marketing and Communication Office, of the IT&C Division, volunteering students, administrative staff, for successfully completing this paramount activity in the life of our academic community.

For remaining enrollment numbers, ASE organized the September intake for all its academic study programs, according to the approved calendar.

The 2023 Admission to ASE process successfully resulted in a record number of more than 10000 admitted candidates for all study programs. Congratulations to all and welcome to ASE's academic community!!



The "Applied Statistics and Data Science" Master's program was granted the EMOS Certification for the second consecutive time

The "Applied Statistics and Data Science" Master's program organized by ASE's Faculty of Economic Cybernetics, Statistics and Informatics was granted the European Master in Official Statistics (EMOS) Certification for the second consecutive time, by the European Statistical System Committee (ESSC). The Label is awarded for a period of 5 years and can be renewed if the program keeps observing the EMOS requirements.

The EMOS network comprises 34 programs in 18 countries and collaborating partners from national statistics institutes, accredited Master's study programs that acquaint students with the system of official statistics, statistical data production models, methods of statistical analysis and dissemination, actively collaborating with national statistical institutes and other producers of official statistics to develop Master's dissertations and carry out internships in the field of official statistics.



Opening of the 2023-2024 academic year

On September 25, 2023, the Bucharest University of Economic Studies organized the Opening ceremonies for the 2023-2024 academic year. ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, together with representatives of the University's Management team – the President of the University's Senate, PhD Prof. Dumitru Miron, and the President of ASE's Students' Union, Doctoral student Andra Mecu, conveyed welcoming messages and wishes for a successful academic year.

The opening addresses were followed by an Award Ceremony for the colleges and high schools whose graduates have become ASE's students in large numbers, as well as for students admitted to each of ASE's Faculties with the highest admission grade. ASE continues the tradition of recognizing its partners in the pre-university environment.





News on Study programs

Inauguration of the "Nicolae D Xenopol" Building in 8 Piața Romană

On the occasion of the opening of the 2023-2024 academic year, ASE's management team inaugurated the "Nicolae D. Xenopol" Building near ASE's Palace in the city center, named after the founding father of our University. Purchased by ASE in 2022, the building in Aft Nouveau was erected in 1903 on the basis of the blueprints of architect Oscar Maugsch, for the renowned Sabba Ştefănescu, paleontologist, geologist, corresponding member of the Romanian Academy.

The newly inaugurated building is to host representative administrative structures of ASE, responsible for the implementation of national and international partnerships, ASE's foreign cultural centers, the institutional accreditation committees, the teams involved in the monitoring of ASE's positioning in international rankings.



The Strategy of the Amfiteatru Economic Journal for 2025

During the month of July 2023, the Strategy of the *Amfiteatru Economic* Journal for 2025, as part of the institutional project "Strategies for the development of ASE's journals". The main objective delineated by the Strategy of the *Amfiteatru Economic* Journal is for the latter to be ranked among the top five publications in its field in Central and South-Eastern Europe in 2025. The elaboration of this Dissertation is part of the partnership agreement between ASE and Nagaoka University of Technology, Japan, being one of the 7 Dissertations elaborated by Japanese students from ASE's Doctoral Schools.

On July 26-28, 2023, ASE and the National Bank of Romania (BNR) organized the Annual Scientific Conference of Romanian Academic Economists from Abroad- ERMAS 2023. The event was hosted by BNR and was opened by Acad. Mugur Isărescu, Governor of BNR, PhD Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, ASE's Vice-rector for International relations, and benefited from the presence of representatives of the Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca, Romania, and of ERMAS.

Keynote speakers: Mariacristina De Nardi, University of Minnesota, David Drukker, Sam Houston State University, Camelia Kuhnen, UNC Kenan-Flagler Business School, Gianluca Violante, Princeton University. The event program included debates on topics related to developments in monetary and fiscal policies, investments, banking institutions, econometrics, real estate industry, education and the labor market etc.





International Conference "Japan: Pre-modern, Modern and Contemporary"

On November 1-3, 2023, ASE's Center of Japanese Studies organized the 10th Conference International "Japan: Premodern, Modern and Contemporary". The event was opened by PhD Prof. Marius Constantin Profiroiu. Vice-rector for International Relations, who emphasized the role of the Center of Japanese Studies in the ASE Japanese liaison between and universities, and in promoting Japanese culture in our University. The event brought together over 40 researchers in more than 10 countries, who debated on various aspects related to the Japanese culture and society, from history and philosophy, to linguistics, pop culture, anthropology, art and literature.





The 10th International Conference on Social Responsibility Ethics and Sustainable Business - ICSR 2023

On September 14-15, 2023, ASE's Faculty of Marketing organized the 10th International Conference on Social Responsibility Ethics and Sustainable Business - ICSR 2023. Previously organized at universities from Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Italy, Norway, Portugal, Spain and Sweden, this anniversary edition was organized and hosted by ASE, and it benefited from the contribution of participants from many countries. The event was opened by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific Research, Development and Innovation. The conference was attended by participants from 16 countries who presented over 50 papers during the parallel sessions. During the conference, a series of special sessions were organized with the participation of specialists from Romania and abroad: Social responsibility and sustainability: past, present and future; Sustainability in the energy sector; Round table on Diversity and Inclusion; The workforce of the future and green skills. The end of the conference was marked by a round table, dedicated to establishing a research agenda in the field of social responsibility and sustainability.



COST Action CA 18236 at ASE

On September 28-29, 2023, ASE hosted the meeting of the SHIINE Management Committee of the COST Action CA 18236 "Multidisciplinary innovation for social change". The event brought together 41 participants from 27 European countries, representatives of the academic environment with multidisciplinary expertise. One of the critical objectives of the meeting was to collaboratively develop public policy recommendations regarding the role of higher education institutions in innovation and social change.

The meeting on September 29, was chaired by Dr. Katri-Liis Lepik from the University of Tallinn, Estonia, and organized by ASE with the support of the country representative within the action, PhD Prof. Carmen Păunescu. The event was opened by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Vice-rector for Scientific Research, Development and Innovation, and PhD Associate prof. Tănase Stamule, Dean of the Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages, who gave presentations on ASE's research in an international context, and its impact on the business and socio-economic environment in Romania.





ASE participated in the European Researchers' Night 2023

On September 29, 2023, the Bucharest University of Economic Studies participated in the 18th edition of the European Researchers' Night 2023, a project initiated by the European Commission. In Romania, researchers from 27 cities and towns met with the public to present their captivating results. ASE was represented at the event by the following faculties: Agrifood and Environmental Economics; Theoretical and Applied Economics; Finance & Banking, as well as by the Association of Students in Economics, Business and Communication. On behalf of ASE, the event was coordinated by PhD Associate prof. Roxana Pătârlăgeanu, Deputy-dean for Scientific Research at the Faculty of Agrifood and Environmental Economics, apart from the activities organized at ASE's stand, the University's representatives also organized a workshop on the topic of "Climate Scenarios for Romania in 2030", which was greatly appreciated by visitors, who debated on topics such as: Green energy, Sustainable agriculture, Climate resilient cities, Biodiversity, Circular economy, Technology solutions for climate, and Climate legislation.

Commercial Diplomacy Week

On July 4, 2023, the Bucharest University of Economic Studies, represented by the Foreign Trade Excellence Center, in partnership with the Faculty of International Business and Economics, and the Romanian Agency for Investments and Foreign Trade organized a debate as part of the Commercial Diplomacy Week. The event hosted by the Aula Magna was opened by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, and benefited from the presence of the President of the Senate of Romania, the representative of the Presidential Administration of Romania, Ministers and state secretaries from the Ministries of Foreign Affairs; Economy, Entrepreneurship and Tourism; Research, Innovation and Digitization; Energy; Investments and European Projects, as well as representatives of the Council of Small and Medium-sized Private Enterprises, the National Sanitary, Veterinary and Food Safety Agency, the Export Council, chambers of commerce, professional associations and employers' confederations, Romanian companies with export activities and academics from ASE. Discussions focused on Romanian commercial diplomacy - trends, challenges, liaison between Foreign Trade Bodies and the business environment.

Delegation from the Arab Republic of Egypt to ASE

On July 20, 2023, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, and PhD Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, Vice-rector for International relations, received a delegation from the Arab Republic of Egypt from the "Higher Institute of Computers, Information and Management Technology in Tanta", led by Dr. Ahmed Diaa Mohamed Khamis, Rector. The delegation participated in several actions within our institution, with the support of the faculties involved in organizing the activities, within the Erasmus+ program. It was agreed to continue the cooperation agreement between our two universities for the next five years.





International visits to ASE
