

On November 1, 2023, the Aula Magna hosted the Extraordinary Meeting of the University's Senate, when our academic community celebrated 110 years since the Official opening of lectures at the university, then called the Academy of High Commercial and Industrial Studies. The celebration was opened by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, and PhD Prof. Dumitru Miron, President of the University's Senate.

The inauguration of lectures took place on Friday, November 1, 1913, in the presence if the 603 newly enrolled students and an impressive number of high officials and leading intellectuals of the time. "This Academy must become a center where all economic activity must concentrate and depend on" said the first Rector of the University, internationally reputed mathematician Anton Davidoglu in his Opening Address. The inauguration of lectures took place in the amphitheater of the building rented and equipped by AISCI on 102 Calea Victoriei (the respective building no longer exists), near today's Central University Library.

Prof. Farkas's cooperation with ASE, via the Faculty of Finance and Banking, has had many facets - from teaching activities at the Master of Applied Finance, to presence in public defense committees for Master's graduation papers for the Master's program in Finance and Banking - DOFIN, to joint authorship of scientific research papers with academic staff members from ASE.





Celebrating the 90th anniversary of the mural painting in ASE's Aula Magna

On November 15, 2023, ASE's academic community celebrated the 90th Anniversary since the completion of the renowned mural painting in ASE's Aula Magna, entitled "The History of Romanian Trade" by artist Cecilia Cutescu-Storck. The event began with the opening of the exhibition entitled "The History of Romanian Trade – creation and restauration stages", a travelling exhibition from the Bucharest Municipality Museum. Throughout the day, ASE's Aula Magna was open for the public, the director of ASE's Museum, Dr. Toma Roman Jr., answered questions on the mural painting or ASE's history. The event program included the conference entitled "90 Years of History of Romanian Trade" on topics related to the saga of the Cutescu-Storck family of artists, the successive restorations of the mural painting, the historical context of its making. Conferral Ceremony of the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa to Prof. Marcel Ausloos

On November 16, 2023, the Aula Magna hosted the festive Gathering of ASE's University's Senate for the Conferral Ceremony of the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa to PhD Professor Marcel Ausloos, Business School, University of Leicester, Great Britain. The proposal of the Faculty of Economic Cybernetics, Statistics and Informatics, sanctioned by the Board of Trustees and the University's Senate, was based on arguments such as Prof. Ausloos's outstanding and innovative contributions to research in the field of econophysics and socio-physics; his partnership with the members of our academic community, which whom he jointly authored scientific works published in internationally prestigious journals and his contribution to the undertaking of two research projects with a consolidated budget of more than 2 million euros.





ASE's Rector - Doctor Honoris Causa of the "Aurel Vlaicu" University of Arad

On November 23, 2023, ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor was conferred the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa of the "Aurel Vlaicu" University of Arad (UAV), as a token of academic recognition for his entire scientific and managerial activity. The event was part of a larger series of celebratory events organized on the occasion of the "Economist's Day" and the "Economics Scholar's Day", during the National Forum of Economists from Romania, attended by a Delegation of ASE's Board of Trustees and the University's Senate. Laudatio underlined the merits of Prof. Istudor as a scientific researcher and manager of the first economic university in Romania, as well as his permanent involvement in addressing the issues arising in the academic community and in society, as part of various professional associations he has been a member of.

ASE in Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2024

For the sixth consecutive year, the Bucharest University of Economic Studies is ranked on notable positions in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject 2024

- in the fields of Social Sciences and Business & Economics.

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies - the leader of Romanian economic and public administration higher education in Romania, is ranked 601-800th overall in the field of Social Sciences and 801+th in the field of Business & Economics, according to the 2024 edition of the prestigious Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject, published on October 26, 2023. THE WUR by Subject 2024 classifies universities on the basis of the following 5 criteria: teaching, research environment, research quality, international outlook and industry.

The Universitaria Consortium is also present in these two domains in the 2024 edition of the Times Higher Education World University Rankings by Subject, through its members: the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" din University of Iaşi, the "Babeş-Bolyai" University of Cluj, the University of Bucharest, the West University of Timişoara, and the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu.

ASE inaugurated a new Amphitheater

On October 3, 2023, ASE inaugurated the Bucharest Stock Exchange (BVB) Amphitheater - Amphitheater 2101, a hall with over 150 seats that was modernized and equipped by the BVB. Following an investment of approximately 80,000 euros, the amphitheater in the "Virgil Madgearu" Building offers students and teachers a modern space for teaching activities. The event was attended by ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, the President of the University's Senate, PhD Prof. Dumitru Miron, BVB President - Radu Hanga, BVB General Manager - Adrian Tănase, Undersecretary of State in the Ministry of Education - Mr. Cătălin Mihai Micu, Executive Director of the Institute of Financial Studies - PhD Prof. Marian Siminică, members of ASE's Board of Directors, academic staff and students.

The modernization of the Amphitheater 2101 was made as part of the educational partnership agreement between ASE and BVB. As part of the latter, BVB representatives participate in courses or seminars with presentations on saving and investment concepts. The project continues in the 2023-2024 academic year, with the aim of contributing, with practical examples, to the completion of the information that students receive about managing finances, the capital market and the stock exchange.





Advanced digital skills training program for members of ASE's academic community

Starting November 2023, ASE organizes the advanced digital skills training program for the members of its academic community, as part of the project entitled "Sustainable University through Digitization. Investments in Research and Education Infrastructure", financed under Component C15 – Education, as part of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan. The program comprises 4 modules: Module 1: Personal productivity in the digital environment (20 hours); Module 2: Artificial Intelligence (40 hours); Module 3: Communication, persuasive online and offline presentation skills based on the use of digital instruments (12 hours); Module 4: Useful applications for collaboration in educational projects (8 hours).

The objective of the project is to train at least 350 teachers so as to develop advanced digital skills.

The advanced digital skills development program continues

Throughout December, ASE organized a new series of training courses part of the advanced digital skills training program for the members of its academic community included in the project entitled "Sustainable University through Digitization. Investments in Research and Education Infrastructure", financed under Component C15 – Education, as part of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan.

The project also comprises actions meant to modernize ASE's digital infrastructure – 8 new research labs (for artificial intelligence, digital urban agriculture, 3D printing, cyber security, virtual and augmented reality, advanced robotics, digital communication, marketing simulations and neuroscience research) and the 10 laboratories of digital transformation of businesses, where the members of the academic community will be able to use modern technologies in the teaching and research process.

ASE launched the promotion campaign for the 2024 Admission Contest for Bachelor's programs

At the beginning of December 2023, ASE launched the promotion campaign of the 2024 Admission Contest for the Bachelor's study programs organized by all of its Faculties.

The novelty is the introduction of written admission exams for two of ASE's Faculties – the Faculty of Economic Cybernetics, Statistics and Informatics (for which candidates are to take an exam in Mathematics) and the Faculty of Law (for which candidates are to take an exam in Romanian and Economics). The promotion campaign for the 2024 Admission Contest began by:

- the publication of the Methodology for Admission to Bachelor's study programs 2024 – version in Romanian is available <u>here</u>, whereas the version in English is available <u>here</u>.
- the elaboration and distribution of information materials flyers, brochures, bookmarks;
- the publishing of advertorials and press releases in the media;
- the 2024 Admission to ASE Educational Caravan in December 2023, ASE organized the 14th edition of the "Admission to ASE" Educational Caravan. Representatives of the Marketing and Communication Office, academic staff members and students, visited colleges and high schools throughout the country, as follows: Alexandria, Buzău, Constanţa, Focşani, Piteşti, Ploieşti, Târgovişte and Slobozia. During the meetings with high school students and their teachers, ASE's representatives presented the admission procedures and the educational offer for the 2024 Bachelor's Admission Competition, also distributing informative materials to benefit future ASE candidates;
- the organization of guided tours for groups of pupils and teachers from High Schools and Colleges in Bucharest and throughout the country.





International Conference "Sustainable Regional Development for the Hunedoara County"

On October 5-7, 2023, the Municipalities of Deva and Hunedoara hosted the Romanian-French International Conference "Sustainable regional development for Hunedoara county". The event was organized by ASE, through its Distance Education Center in Deva, the County Council of Hunedoara, the University of Artois, Arras, France, and the Hunedoara City Hall. The event was attended by numerous academics from ASE and the University of Artois. The opening of the event was held at the County Council of Hunedoara, and brought together representatives of ASE's Delegation, led by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, and by the President of the University's Senate, PhD Prof. Dumitru Miron, representatives of the French delegation from the University of Artois in Arras, led by PhD Prof. Philippe Duez, Dean of the Faculty of Economics, Management and Social Sciences, members of the academic environment and of the local public administration. During the conference, discussions focused on topics related to the sustainable development strategies of the territory, the sustainability of public services, the sustainable planning of water resources, etc. The event program included a workshop hosted by the Corvinilor Castle in Hunedoara, held on October 6.





International Research and Training Week in ASE

On October 9-13, 2023, ASE hosted the "International Research and Training Week", which benefited from the participation of academics and researchers from Poland, Slovakia and Spain. Debates, presentations, networking activities and online meetings continued throughout the month of October. The project was designed and coordinated by PhD Prof. Laura Mureşan, with the support of the Department of Modern Languages and Business Communication from ASE's Faculty of International Business and Economics, and of the Erasmus+ Office from ASE's International Relations Division. The event was opened by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific research, development and innovation.





The CACTUS 2023 International Conference

On October 12-13, 2023, the CACTUS 2023 International Tourism Conference "Technologies applied in Hospitality, Travel and Tourism", was organized by ASE's Faculty of Business and Tourism in partnership with the CACTUS Centre for Research in Tourism and Services. The message of ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, was conveyed by PhD Prof. Alina Mihaela Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific research, development and innovation. ASE's Management team was also represented by the President of the University's Senate, PhD Prof. Dumitru Miron, and PhD Prof. Răzvan Cătălin Dobrea, Vice-rector for Economic and Financial Management. The event was hosted by the Virgil Madgearu Room, with quests from Bulgaria, China, Indonesia, Italy, France and from Romania (various universities in Cluj-Napoca, Iași, Sibiu and Bucharest). Plenary speakers: Prof. Giacomo Del Chiappa from the University of Sassari, Italy; Prof. Stanislav Ivanov from the University of Management in Varna, Bulgaria and, from the business environment, Mr. Laurent Picheral from the ACCOR Group, France. The first day's program included paper and poster presentations. On the second day of the conference, the program included an itinerant workshop in the Buzău Land UNESCO Global Geopark, a land full of undiscovered natural and anthropogenic tourism resources.





Conference entitled "The Circular Economy in Romania: from Challenges to Opportunities"

On October 13, 2023, ASE's Aula Magna hosted the Conference entitled "The Circular Economy in Romania: from Challenges to Opportunities", organized by Green News Romania in partnership with the Circular Economy Coalition (CERC). The event was opened by PhD Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, Vice-rector for International relations. Mr. Mircea Geoană, Deputy Secretary General of NATO gave the first keynote speech, in the presence of representatives of the business environment. The event brought together key representatives of companies involved in the current circular economy, companies going through transition processes and state authorities. The conference addressed important topics such as economic security in Europe, fluctuations in taxation on micro-enterprises, waste collection and flow, production chain challenges, the potential of the circular economy, financial risks and the sustainability of the region, as well as aspects related to local and European sustainability models and experiences of local communities in responsible waste management and recovery.





Applied training workshop

On October 17-22, 2023, the Applied training workshop for the "Simulation of decision-making processes in the business environment, through business games" was organized as part of the research project CNFIS-FDI-2023-F-0159 - Innovative development of students' practical and digital skills for integration in a business environment characterized by uncertainty, based on agility, connectivity and resilience, director – PhD Prof. Dorel Mihai Paraschiv, Vice-rector for Liaison with the economic and social environment and cooperation with students.

Training sessions were held online, whereas the competition was held at the "Ion Gh. Roşca" Training Center Complex in Predeal on October 19-22, 2023. The activity benefited from the participation of students, academics and project experts from four universities: the Bucharest University of Economic Studies, the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iaşi, the "Babeş-Bolyai" University of Cluj-Napoca, the "1 Decembrie 1918" University of Alba Iulia. The 38 third year Bachelor's students worked in pairs, and the hierarchy at the end of the business games was the following:

On October 26-27, 2023, ASE's Faculty of International Business and Economics organized the 14th International Conference entitled "The Future of Europe". This year's edition focused on issues regarding resilience and sustainability, climate change and EU policies in this field, the relationship between the Republic of Moldova and Romania from the perspective of the European integration process, the role of economic diplomacy in international promotion, as well as combating fake news in the public space. Among the guest speakers, we mention Prof. Jacques Pelkmans from the College of Europe, Belgium, Prof. Andras Inotai from the Institute for World Economy, Budapest, Prof. Ilya Lingorski from the University of Sofia/ National Bank of Bulgaria, Prof. Yoram Krozer from the Technical University in Graz, Austria, and Prof. Dionysis Skarmeas from the Athens University of Economics and Business, Greece. The partners of the conference were the Institute for World Economy and the European Institute in Romania. ASE partially redeemed his image after 1990, by granting him the "Virgil Madgearu" Medal and granting him the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa in 2017.








Book launch: "In Memoriam: Paul Bran - Key figure of academic rebirth"






Visit to ASE



CSU ASE results in Basketball
