

Festive Gathering of ASE's University's Senate for the Conferral Ceremony of the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa of ASE to Prof. Jean Tirole, Nobel Prize Laureate

On September 26, 2024, ASE's Aula Magna hosted the Festive Gathering of ASE's University's Senate for the Conferral Ceremony of the Honorary Title of Doctor Honoris Causa of ASE to Professor Jean Tirole, 2014 Nobel Prize Laureate for Economics.

This title was bestowed by ASE following the proposal of the Board of Trustees, unanimously adopted by the University's Senate, as a token of recognition of the outstanding achievements of Prof. Jean Tirole – born on August 5, 1953, internationally renowned French economist, alumnus of Ecole Polytechnique, Paris (1976), and Ecole Nationale des Ponts et Chaussées, Paris (1978). Currently, Prof. Tirole is Honorary President of Fondation Jean-Jacques Laffont/Toulouse Sciences Economiques (TSE), University of Toulouse, France, Scientific Director of the Toulouse School of Economics, Founding member and Honorary president of the Executive Committee of the Institute for Advanced Study in Toulouse - IAST and Visiting Professor at MIT Economics.

ASE in QS World University Rankings: Eastern Europe 2025

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies climbs in the "QS World University Rankings: Eastern Europe 2025", being now ranked 63 out of 133 world universities, and 6th out of 17 Romanian universities. This year's edition was released on July 10, 2024 - <u>https://www.topuniversities.com/europe-university-rankings-</u>eastern-europe.

ASE has made constant efforts to be better evaluated according to the criteria in the methodology: academic reputation, employer reputation, citations per paper, papers per faculty, international research network, employment outcomes, faculty student ratio, international student diversity, international faculty ratio, inbound exchange student ratio, outbound exchange student ratio and sustainability score.



ASE – the first university in South-Eastern Europe to be included in QS Executive MBA Rankings

ASE announces its inclusion in the prestigious <u>QS Executive MBA</u> <u>Rankings 2024: Joint Programmes,</u> with the <u>ROCA Executive MBA</u> (<u>Romanian-Canadian</u>) <u>program</u> ranked 27 out of 222 evaluated programs. The ROCA Executive MBA is jointly organized by ASE's Bucharest Business School (BBS@ASE) and École des Sciences de la Gestion - ESG from Université Quebeque a Montreal – UQAM, Canada.

After obtaining the AMBA international accreditation in 2023, thus making ASE's Bucharest Business School part of a global network of 300 accredited business schools, Romania's best economic and business university has now received yet another token of recognition of the quality and value of its MBA/Executive MBA programs. The QS Executive MBA Rankings 2024 evaluates MBA programs across the world based on criteria such as academic quality and employer satisfaction, as well as participants' executive profile, career progression, and diversity. To have been included in this prestigious ranking is a testament to the University's committment to offer high quality education to business leaders in South-Eastern Europe.





ASE in the World University Rankings for Innovation (WURI) 2024

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies is included for the fourth consecutive year in the World University Rankings for Innovation (WURI) and in the 2024 edition is ranked 120th in the Global Top 300 Innovative Universities, and 51st in Crisis Management.

This year's competition was higher compared to previous editions, as the number of universities selected for participation was 1072 universities at world level, as opposed to 423 universities in the previous year. Moreover, the number of innovation cases analyzed for the WURI 2024 edition is 2916 – three times higher than the previous year.

The evaluation committee, consisting of 156 university presidents/rectors from around the world, analyzed and deliberated on this classification on the basis of three criteria: degree of innovation, implementation and impact.



Recognition of ASE from the Internal Audit Awareness programs

ASE received recognition as part of the Internal Audit Awareness program of the Institute of Internal Auditors, following efforts undertaken by ASE's Faculty of Accounting and Information Management Systems.

The Internal Audit Awareness program was created to acknowledge the commitment and efforts of universities towards equipping students with the necessary knowledge and skills for a career in internal auditing. The Institute of Internal Auditors contributes to the professional training of students, so as to meet the labor market demand for skilled graduates, by supporting accredited higher education institutions which meet specific quality criteria and significantly contribute to the educational progress in the field of internal auditing.

This recognition not only highlights excellence in internal audit study programs, but also consolidates ASE's reputation as a leader in the education of future internal auditing practitioners.

First Class of Alumni from ASE's Faculty of Law – outstanding Bachelor's graduation results

During the month of July 2024, the first class of Alumni from ASE's Faculty of Law took their Bachelor's graduation exams at the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iaşi, together with the latter's graduates. Out of 58 graduates, 56 successfully passed the exam; the highest mark for the written exam was 9.90 out of 10, and was obtained by an Alumnus from ASE.

Admission to ASE 2024 - July intake

In July 2024, ASE organized the summer intake of the Admission contest for Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral programs, with the exemplary participation of academic and administrative staff members.

During the month of July, ASE conducted numerous and diversified promotion activities, designed and coordinated by the University's Marketing and Communication Office. During the admission process, ASE's well known call-center was operative 8 hours a day, the only such academic call-center in Romania, where Bachelor's candidates interacted with student members of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies Students' Union representatives (USASE) and of the Marketing and Communication Office to discuss about various stages and details regarding the admission process. Over 9500 telephone calls, Facebook, Instagram and email gueries were answered to.









Admission to ASE 2024 - July intake

In July, 11634 candidates registered for Bachelor's programs, which represents more than 10% of the high school graduates this year. At the end of the Admission process, ASE selected 6775 Bachelor's candidates, 2796 Master's candidates and 137 Doctoral candidates. ASE's Board of Trustees wishes to thank all those involved in the preparation and conduct of the Admission process: members of Central Admission Committees and Registration Committees, Exam Committees, of the Marketing and Communication Office, USASE and other student organizations, the IT&C Division, academics, volunteering students, administrative staff members, for the success of this paramount activity for our community.

Data Science International Summer School 2024

On July 20-28, 2024, ASE's Bucharest Business School organized the 5th Data Science International Summer School, a unique program in Central and Eastern Europe, aimed at professionals and students with a keen interest in data science. The Data Science International Summer School has a substantial contribution to the implementation of the University's internationalization strategy.

The event was organized in partnership with the Gala Institute of the Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski", Bulgaria, and team projects from enRichMyData, Graph-Massivizer, UPCAST and INT END. It brought together students, researchers and professionals from universities and organizations on 4 continents: 65 participants with expertise in data science, from Austria, Italy, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, South Korea, Tunisia, and the USA.

Guest speakers came from renowned academic and research institutions, such as University of Chicago and University of North Carolina at Charlotte (USA), Wageningen University & Research (The Netherlands), London Metropolitan University (UK), Oslo Metropolitan University and SINTEF (Norway), University of Klagenfurt (Austria).



Bucharest Summer University "Digital Transformation for New Business Models"

On August 11-25, 2024, ASE organized the 18th edition of the Bucharest Summer University, in cooperation with the Bucharest University of Economic Studies Students' Union (USASE), The student Senate, the Association of Faculties of Economics from Romania (AFER) and Alumni ASE, under the patronage of the Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages. This year's edition was "Digital Transformation for New Business Models"; aim: to engage students from over 20 countries in dialogue and debates with established specialists, both from academia and business, promoting the exchange of ideas and presenting innovative solutions to problems arising in the business field.

The program included educational and cultural activities such as: courses and debates with business specialists, visits to companies -E&Y, Deloitte, P&G, UiPath, tours of the capital city, visits to museums in Bucharest, a trip to the country etc.

News on Study programs

Summer Schools organized by ASE's Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages

• "Entrepreneurship and German Language 2024"

During July 21 - August 2 and August 4-16, 2024, the 11th edition of the Summer school in Entrepreneurship and German Language was organized in Brasov by the members of the UNESCO Department of Business Administration from ASE's Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages. It was an excellent opportunity for participants from ASE and other universities and high schools to improve their entrepreneurial, economic and German language skills. The program included presentations on entrepreneurial, economic and socio-cultural topics delivered by academic staff from the organizing Faculty and ASE's Bucharest Business School, as well as bv representatives of strategic partners – Konrad Adenauer Stiftung, Kaufland Romania, Radio Romania – the German language broadcast. Also, in each module, a minimum of 40 hours of intensive German language courses were organized.



• "Entrepreneurship and French Language 2024"

During August 18-30, 2024, the 6th edition of the Summer school in Entrepreneurship and French Language was organized in Predelut, the county of Brasov, by he UNESCO Department of Business Administration from ASE's Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages, to bring together participants wiht an interest in French, as well as entrepreneurship. The event was an opportunity for preand university students to develop their university professional and networking skills. language, in а collaborative and dynamic environment. The program included 40 hours of intensive French classes, workshops conferences delivered by academics and from the organizing Faculty and quest entrepreneurs, who shared their experiences on navigating a globalized business environment.





Summer School entitled "Entrepreneurship in Medical Tourism"

On September 9-14, 2024, ASE's Professional Training Center in Covasna hosted the Summer School entitled "Entrepreneurship in Medical Tourism", organized by ASE's Faculty of Business and Tourism.

The program was designed so as to offer participants a unique opportunity to gain knowledge in the field of health tourism, a sector with high development potential. During the five days, participants were involved in activities aimed at developing entrepreneurial skills specific to this field, by combining theory with practical examples. The main objective of the summer school was to explore the opportunities and challenges in this sector, while providing a framework for collaboration between students and professionals in the field.

The program proved to be a valuable experience both educationally and professionally. Participants had the opportunity to learn from practical examples and collaborate with experts in the field, which helped them develop essential skills for their future careers. The Summer School was an effective platform for promoting health tourism and stimulating entrepreneurial spirit, while providing a solid network of contacts and collaborators.





The Regional Summer School on Cultural Entrepreneurship

On September 16-20, 2024, *the* Francophone University Agency in Central and Eastern Europe (AUF-ECO) and ASE jointly organized the first edition of the Regional Summer School on Cultural Entrepreneurship.

The event was opened in Aula Magna by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Sorin Cîmpeanu, President of the Francophone University Agency and Rector of University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest (USAMV), Eric Poppe, representative of AUF-ECO, H.E. Mr. Do Duc Thanh, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of *the* Socialist Republic of Viet Nam to Romania, H.E. Mr. Tigran Galstyan, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Armenia in Romania, Ms. Amira Mihăilescu, Minister Plenipotentiary, national correspondent for Francophonie, Minister of Foreign Affairs, a.o.

Under the aegis of the 30th Anniversary of AUF-ECO, this event was part of the regional project for the development of student entrepreneurship and entrepreneurial culture. This first edition of the Regional Summer School on Cultural Entrepreneurship brought together students from 10 countries: Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Hungary, North Macedonia, Poland, the Republic of Moldova, Romania, Slovakia and Ukraine.



Opening Ceremonies for the 2024-2025 academic year

On September 30, 2024, ASE organized the Opening Ceremonies for the 2024-2025 academic year. The university-level Opening Ceremony was hosted by the Aula Magna in ASE's Palace. The event was opened by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, Rector, PhD Prof. Gheorghe Hurduzeu, President of the University's Senate, PhD Prof. Pavel Năstase, ASE's Rector between 2012 – 2016, the directors of the "Mihai Viteazu" and "St. Sava" National Colleges in Bucharest, the president of the Bucharest University of Economic Studies Students' Union (USASE). The opening addresses were followed by an Award Ceremony for the colleges and high schools whose graduates have become ASE's students in large numbers, as well as for students admitted to each of ASE's Faculties with the highest admission grade. ASE continues the tradition of recognizing its partners in the pre-university environment.







Conference entitled "ASE 4.0 - Sustainable University through Digitization. Presentation of Investments in Education"

On July 11, 2024, ASE's Aula Magna hosted the Conference entitled "ASE 4.0 - Sustainable University through Digitization. Presentation of Investments in Education" (code 384388931), worth 39.5 mil. RON.

The event was opened by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, speakers: PhD Prof. Ionela Costică, Vice-rector for Education, PhD Prof. Dan Dumitrescu, Vice- rector for Management of Human Resources and European Funds, PhD Prof. Ion Smeureanu – project manager.

The event program included a presentation of the investments made in the University's IT infrastructure through this EU-funded project, part of the National Plan for Recovery and Resilience, as well as the Graduation Ceremony for the Advanced digital skills training program for the members of the academic community.

Starting October 2024, students will benefit from 18 new research labs, the members of the academic community will be able to use modern technologies in teaching and research, made available in the 10 labs for digital business transformation, and in lecture and seminar rooms endowed with state-of-the-art equipment for interactive and collaborative learning.



Projects won by ASE in the month of July

- ASE's Faculty of Management won the project entitled "ECO-SUCCESS Advanced internship program dedicated to future professionals in the economic field", worth over 4.9 mil. RON, project manager: PhD Prof. Răzvan Cătălin Dobrea, as part of the Education and Employment Operational Program 2021 2027. By means of this project, 270 Bachelor's and Master's students are to benefit, in the following two years, of internships, career counseling, contests and other activities aimed at increasing their level of professional training and their access to the labor market.
- ASE won the project entitled "Consolidation, rehabilitation and modernization of the C2 building – Bucharest University of Economic Studies", worth over 12.3 mil. RON, project manager: PhD Prof. Răzvan Cătălin Dobrea, as part of the Bucharest-Ilfov Regional Program 2021-2027. The project aims to insure the necessary financing for the completion of the modernization of the Moxa B Building, to create modern educational and research facilities, as well as a new Data Center for our university.

International Conference on Information Technology and Quantitative Management - ITQM 2024

On August 23-25, 2024, ASE hosted the 11th edition of the International Conference on Information Technology and Quantitative Management - ITQM 2024, organized by ASE, the International Academy of Information Technology and Quantitative Management (IAITQM) and their partners. The ITQM Conference is a leading scientific event in the field of Information Technology.

International Conference on Japanese Studies

On September 2-4, 2024, ASE's Centre of Japanese Studies, in partnership with the Faculty of International Business and Economics, the Department for Modern Languages and Business Communication and four universities from Japan organized the 11th edition of the International Conference entitled "Japan: Pre-Modern, Modern and Contemporary". The hybrid event brought together ca 70 researchers from 15 countries, with articles on various aspects related to Japanese studies.

The event benefited from the participation of H.E. Mr. Takashi Katae, Ambassador of Japan to Bucharest, whose closing speech referred to the support offered by the Embassy of Japan to the Bucharest University of Economic Studies in the development of Japanese studies in Romania.



Research seminar for Doctoral students and young researchers


On September 12, 2024, ASE's Faculty of Accounting and Management Information Systems hosted a lecture delivered by PhD Associate prof. Vlad-Andrei Porumb, University of Manchester, Alliance Manchester Business School. The event was organized as part of the research project PN-IV- P2-2.2-MCT-2024-0062, in charge: PhD Prof. Liliana Feleagă, Dean of ASE's Faculty of Accounting and Management Information Systems.

The seminar was especially aimed at Doctoral students and young researchers, so as to develop their academic research skills.

Conference on "Rules and Reasoning (RuleML+PR)" hosted by ASE

On September 16-18, 2024, ASE's Bucharest Business School and the team of the Master's program in Business Analytics organized by ASE's Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages organized the 8th edition of the International IT&C conference entitled "Rules and Reasoning (RuleML+RR)". The event was organized as part of the partnership between ASE, the Oslo Metropolitan University - OsloMet and SINTEF, one of the largest research institutes in Europe, with multidisciplinary applied expertise in technology and natural sciences. The 2024 edition of the conference brought together participants from various countries, such as France, Germany, Norway, Poland, Romania and Turkey, and put a special emphasis on the topic of Declarative AI.

ASE's organizing team comprised academics with expertise in AI and Data Science from the Faculty of Business Administration in Foreign Languages, the Faculty of Economic Cybernetics, Statistics and Informatics, and the Business Economics Data Science Lab.



Event organized in ASE as part of the NEXOGENESIS project

On September 17-19, 2024, ASE's Faculty of Agrifood and Environmental Economics hosted the event entitled "Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystems Nexus for Sustainable Development", organized as part of the NEXOGENESIS project. The event was organized by Business Development Group in partnership with ASE, the Department for Sustainable Development from the General Secretariat of the Government, the National Administration Romanian Waters and the Jiu Water Basin Administration.

The NEXOGENESIS project has been funded by the European Commission's Horizon 2020 Framework since 2021, and includes a case study in Romania, in the Jiu Water Basin. The project approaches its closure and promotes a decision support instrument for the implementation of public policies in four sectors – the value of the NEPAT tool is mainly an educational one.

The event was opened by PhD Prof. Mihaela Alina Dima, Vice-rector for Scientific research, development and innovation. Guest speakers: László Borbély., State councilor at the Department for Sustainable Development, H.E. Mr. Willemijn Van Haaften, Ambassador of The Kingdom of the Netherlands in Romania a.o. The event program also included a practical session for the use of NEPAT, coordinated by project partner EURECAT, aimed at specialists in the field, as well as at academic staff members from ASE. The partnership represents the basis for the future development of academic and research relations with universities from The Netherlands, Spain, Greece and Romania.



Launch of the EMERGE Romania project

On September 18, 2024, ASE and its partners from Romania -S.C. Energy Advisor S.R.L. (Renergia), the Politehnica University of Timişoara, the Municipality of Alba Iulia, the Buteni Commune (Arad County) and the Crucea Commune (Constanța County), and from Norway - Smart Innovation Norway, launched the research project entitled "EMERGE Romania – EMpowering Communities for EneRGy Transition towards Carbon NEutrality in Romania".

The project si worth 260579 EUR and is funded by means of the EEA and Norway Grants, part of the Program entitled "Funds for Bilateral Relations EEA and Norway grants for Romania".

The strategic partners undertaking the project aim to stimulate innovation in the economic and energy fields, with a focus on energy communities as an emerging innovation in the sector. This collaboration represents a joint commitment to increasing the quality of university education in Romania, through bilateral knowledge transfer, encouragement of applied research and development of university infrastructure.

European Researchers' Night

On September 27, 2024, ASE participated in the 19th edition of the European Researchers' Night, an event initiated by the European Commission, which brought together members of the public with researchers and scientists in over 400 cities from 26 countries.

ASE participated in the Bucharest events, by means of workshops organized by the following Faculties: Accounting and Management Information Systems; Agrifood and Environment Economics; Business and Tourism; Finance and Banking; Management; Theoretical and Applied Economics. Moreover, the program also included workshops organized by the Association of Students in Agrifood and Environmental Economics (ASEAM).

The workshops organized by ADR focused on aspects such as: the quality and duration of sleep, climate scenarios for Romania 2030, financial education for sustainable development: VR and tourist destinations in Romania, experiential learning through business decision-making simulation games, innovative approaches to the teaching process - the use of managerial games in teaching activity etc.



Strategic Partnership Agreement between ASE and UPSD

On July 8, 2024, ASE hosted the signing of the Strategic Partnership agreement between the Bucharest University of Economic Studies and the Dragomirești Special Products Factory (UPSD), represented by ASE's Rector, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, and, the Director General of UPSD, Dr. jr. Corneliu Vișoianu.

The agreement provides for a long-term collaboration between the two institutions, based on objectives such as: opportunities for internships and private scholarships for ASE students; participation of UPSD specialists in courses and conferences organized by ASE; undertaking of joint research studies; participation in the implementation of projects with non-reimbursable funding; supporting scientific activities organized by ASE.





ASE – represented at the celebration of the National Romanian Accountant Day

On July 15, 2024, the Body of Expert and Licensed Accountants of Romania (CECCAR) organized an Anniversary event to celebrate since the 103 vears appearance of regulations for the accountancy profession in Romania. Silver medal for CSU ASE at the National Beach Volley Championship




