

The 12th International Management Conference - IMC 2018

On November 1-2, 2018, ASE's Faculty of Management, in partnership with the Romanian Academic Society of Management (SAMRO), organized the 12th edition of the **International Management Conference "Management Perspectives in the Digital Era" - IMC 2018**. The event was opened by PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector. Debates focused on the following topics: business administration, project management and organizational performance; knowledge management and innovation; strategic management, change management and entrepreneurship; human resources management, organizational culture and leadership; cultural management, behavioral sciences and business ethics.

On November 7, 2018, PhD Prof. Nicolae Istudor, ASE's Rector, participated in the Conference entitled "The Romanian Economic Model in EU. Romania – Horizon 2040", organized under the aegis of the Romanian Academy of Sciences by the Economic and Social Studies and Forecasts Association (ASPES), in partnership with the General Association of Economists in Romania (AGER), The Bucharest University of Economic Studies, the National Institute for Economic Research (INCE) etc. Debates focused on the following issues: Why is an economic model necessary for the EU? What type of economy is needed in Romania during the second decade since its accession to the EU? The state's role in implementing the Romania economic model in the EU.

Joint Conferences of the Faculty of International Business and Economics

On November 22-23, 2018, ASE's Faculty of International Business and Economics organized the 9th edition of the **Annual International Conference "Future of Europe"** and the 7th edition of the **International Conference "Synergies in Communication"**. The events

were organized in partnership with the National Bank of Romania, which hosted the plenary session and a series of panel session.

The conferences were opened by PhD Prof. Liviu Voinea, Deputy governor with the National Bank of Romania, PhD Prof. Dorel Paraschiv, Vice-rector for Liaison with the social and economic environment and cooperation with students, PhD Prof. Gheorghe Hurduzeu, Dean of the Faculty of International Business and Economics. Among the participants in this year's edition of the joint conferences, we mention researchers, academics, and representatives of the business environment from 25 countries: Australia, Austria, Canada, Croatia, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, India, Iran, Italy, Japan, Lithuania, The Netherlands, Poland, the Republic of Moldova, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, the United States of America, Turkey and Ukraine.





Meeting of the Universitaria Consortium in Bucharest

On November 23-25, 2018, **the Universitaria Consortium held a meeting** in Bucharest, hosted by the University of Bucharest. The event was attended by Rectors, Vice-rectors, Presidents of University Senates, Communication Directors, Administrative Directors, student representatives from the five highest-ranked Romanian universities, as well as representatives of the Moldova State University, welcomed as an associate member, with a view to participate in the enhancement of cooperation efforts in Romanian higher education and research.

Participants debated in pannels dedicated to academic, doctoral, internationalization and research issues, as well as to the liaison with the business environment, communication and public relations, student activities. Discussions highlighted the Universities' commitment to

maintain the quality of the teaching activities and arrived at suggestions for optimization, as follows:

- the promotion by the Ministry of National Education together with leading Romanian universities, of a strategic long-term approach (for at least 20 years) to ensure the development of higher education and research;
- the increase in financing per student so as to arrive at a similar financing level to other European countries;
- the enactment of legislative changes so as to simplify procedures for concluding partnerships with foreign universities for Joint and Double Degree programs;
- the development of national projects coordinated by the National Qualifications Authority and the design of learning outcomes;
- the allocation of state-subsidized enrolment numbers and grants for Doctoral studies for the 2019 Admission based on results obtained in prestigious international rankings, in the absence of a national university ranking;
- the exemption of universities from the obligation to decrease material expenses by 10% by the end of 2018 as per the Government Emergency Order 90/2017, as well as the firm commitment of the Ministry of National Education to pay the liabilities stipulated by Law 85/2016, reiterated by Law 95/2018, adjusted to inflation, and for Law 153/2017;
- the return to the possibility of matriculating foreign students by the end of the first semester of the academic year;
- the improvement of the quality of student life and the enhancement of student representativeness in decision-making bodies.

The meeting of the Universitaria Consortium highlighted the commitment of the five leading Romanian universities to act jointly so as to enhance the quality of education standards in Romania.
